Post near your phone for quick reference

Need Police, Fire, Ambulance,  
other safety services?

## 1) Call 911

- Be direct, speak calmly & slowly
- Give exact location, ex: "Washington and Green, in Jamaica Plain, in Boston"
- Give as much detail as possible: Where you are, what's happening, who's involved, what they look like?

Call 911 for any incidents including suspicious activity. "No call is too small."

## 2) Follow up

It's important to let others know about what's going on so they can take preventative action and alerts others. Please follow up by contacting your building security and the Community Service office at 617-343-5624.

The "Telephone Tree":  
a network of your neighbors

After calling 911 or Police, call those in the Telephone Tree to alert them of the incident. If this incident continues they in turn should call 911 or Police to reinforce a response.

## Easy and Effective Safety Tips

### HOME:

- Introduce yourself to your neighbors
- Lock ALL doors and windows
- Don't buzz in anyone you don't know
- Turn your front and rear porch lights on
- Leave the radio on a talk show when your out and put the light on timers

### AUTO:

- Don't leave anything in your cars. Not even clothes or empty bottles.
- Park in a well lit area. Alarms and Clubs deter criminals.

### WALKING:

- Walk with or near group of people
- Walk without iPod/walkman earbuds and don't talk on your cell phone.

### GENERAL:

- Keep your eyes & ears open to suspicious activity, reporting any to 911. "No call is too small."
- Follow up on your 911 call with a call to Drug Sgt, Auto Investigator, or Community Service Office at 617.343.5624 if appropriate
- Respond to cries for help or whistle alerts by calling 911, then blow your whistle or make noise on your street.
- Sign up for the BPD Alert Network [www.CitizenObserver.com](http://www.CitizenObserver.com)
- Text "Tip" to Crime (27463) for anonymous crime reporting and prevention.
- Call the party line to report loud parties at 617-343-5500.
